# DIGITAL INNOVATION GATE FOR THE 21 CENTURY



An architecture that becomes landscape, an innovation district that opens up to the territory, a building that triggers and enhances intelligence. The DIG421 (Digital Innovation Gate For the 21st Century), is the core of a new contemporary collaborative village with a positive impact, capable of generating long-term value for the territory. The DIG421 was conceived by Nemesi as a physical infrastructure capable of expressing the idea of technological experimentation. The office complex, made of concrete, steel and glass, organised in modular volumes, recalls the binary digital language. The axis it generates, parallel to the company's headquarters which will be completed in 2024, will be

further developed in the coming months, giving shape to a front open to the landscape characterised by a rhythmic sequence of volumes whose perception of dynamism and lightness will be emphasised by a scenographic green wall made of painted steel tubes. Studio Nemesi designed the master plan for Tesisquare, the new technological campus of which DIG421 is the first step, which envisages a continuous articulation between workspaces, meeting places and green areas. In addition, the landscaping and urban development programme envisages the provision for citizens of a large park, an open-air theatre and cycle paths linking the district to the nearby town of Brà.
